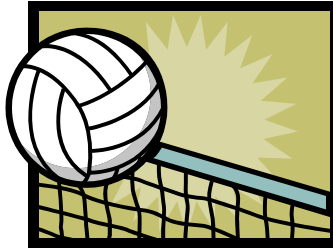


Winter Walleyball, 2010!
